GENERAL INFORMATION

The West Coast Last Chance Meet will be held at San Francisco State University's Cox Stadium and is hosted by the University of San Francisco. All running events, jumps and javelin will be contested on Saturday, May 13 @San Francisco State University. The following events will be contested at Cal State Stanislaus on Friday, May 12: Hammer, Shot, Discus and Pole Vault. This meet is open to ALL college, junior college, unattached, and club athletes registered with USATF.

ENTRY INFORMATION

We cannot guarantee that an entry will be accepted into the meet. Depending on the number of entries per event, some events may be subject to cancellation and refunds will be given for those cancellations.

TFFRS marks from Indoor and Outdoor seasons will be the primary method for seeding. Placement in heats/flights will be at the discretion of the meet management staff. If an athlete does not have a TFFRS time, they must enter a mark that can be verified online. If you have an athlete who is listed as a NT/ND, or you are concerned about them falling into the wrong flight/heat because of their current TFRRS PR, you'll need to submit a seeding mark to (trackcoach@usfca.edu) PRIOR TO THE CLOSE OF ENTRIES (the sooner the better)!

All entries must be done online via Runnercard @ www.runnercard.com.

Entry Fees

Unattached/Individual Athletes \$25/event, \$40/relay team.

Team Entries

\$25/event or \$450 per gender max.

ALL payments for entries will be required online at RunnerCard before entry deadline. Entries will not be final until paid. No entry fees will be collected on the day of the meet.

Important Dates

- Entries Open April 1st
- Entries Close May 9th at 5pm

*NO entries/changes will be accepted after the entry deadline!

• Heat Sheets/Finalized Time Schedule – All schedules and entries will be tentative until the final heat sheets and schedule will be posted online at USFDons.com on Thursday May 11th.

WEIGHTS AND MEASURES

Weights and Measures time and location will be posted with final meet entry/schedule. Implements must be inspected 30' prior to competition.

CHECK-IN

- Event check in opens 90 minutes prior to start of event
- Athletes must check in no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of their event or will be scratched
- Hip numbers will be distributed and athletes should report to the starting line 10 minutes prior to the start time.
- For all field events, athletes should check in at event site.

TRAINERS/MEDICAL

Trainers will be available at the event in the training tent located near the entrance of the track (near restrooms and weights & measures).

ADMISSION

Spectator admission is free. Spectators are not allowed on the track or field.

DIRECTIONS AND PARKING INFORMATION

Cox Stadium is located at 1600 Holloway Ave, San Francisco, CA 94132.

The nearest parking garage is LOT 20.

General paid public, visitor/guest, student parking

- Open 24-hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Parking Permit required. All day permit can be purchased at lot location.

The track facility is located just east of the LOT 20 parking garage. Walk up the stairs from the garage or across the pedestrian bridge at the roof top level, then up the hill and left down the ramp entrance to the track.

Al Brenda Track at Cal State Stanislaus is located adjacent to the Student Recreation Complex. Parking is free in Lot #8.

RESTRICTIONS

- No headphones are allowed in the competition area
- Flats or track shoes with spikes no longer than ¹/₄" will be allowed for ALL events excluding javelin and high jump.
- Finish line area is for officials and clerks only. Please stay clear of this area.



The easiest way to access the LOT 20 parking garage is to turn on State Drive from Lake Merced Blvd. LOT 20 will be on your left at the end of State Drive. It is a public parking lot but permits are required.
